We have had a very exciting and eventful year with many major milestones, accomplishments, and new beginnings!

In April, Rockwood celebrated the opening of Rockwood at Whitworth's Northland building, a 117-unit independent living addition. Sales have been very successful with occupancy already over 83%, and we have welcomed over 140 new residents to their new homes. The opening marked the culmination of a 4-year redevelopment including the building and opening of the healthcare building, Palvella Glen, during the pandemic.

It is exciting to see the energy of new activities happening at the Rockwood at Whitworth campus along with our growing relationship with Whitworth University. We look forward to the ongoing benefits to both of our organizations.

With the growth and expansion of the Northland, Human Resources successfully hired and welcomed over 44 new employees in the past year. Rockwood continues to capitalize on opportunities for employee development and advancement, while navigating ongoing regulation changes which included the 2023 mandated minimum wage increase of 8.63% and additional labor market pressures. We continue to celebrate our team members and value their dedicated service to our residents.

In July, Rockwood celebrated 33 years of leadership with the retirement of CEO Alan Curryer. Alan joined Rockwood in November 1990 as CFO and served as CEO since 2003. Alan can be very proud of the incredible legacy he led for over half of Rockwood's history.

The Board performed a national search for a replacement and Jim Maxwell, who has been Rockwood's CFO, rose above the rest and was promoted to CEO. Jim has been actively involved in the success of Rockwood for the past 19 years and looks forward to leading Rockwood into the future.

Rockwood Residents' Foundation continues to provide positive impacts to Rockwood's residents and team members. The Foundation celebrated the dedication of the Legacy Terrace on the Rockwood at Whitworth campus, had a successful auction, provided scholarship support to team members and their children, and rebranded its planned giving program to "The Rockwood Legacy Circle."

Rockwood continues to benefit from ongoing strategic and master planning, and financial strength. We hope you enjoy learning about this year's highlights, including our new Physician Clinic at Rockwood South Hill. Rockwood strives to continue to offer what many current and future residents desire and to stay innovative and healthy into the future.



This year brought a huge milestone for Rockwood Retirement Communities with the completion of redevelopment of the Rockwood Hawthorne community – now transformed into Rockwood at Whitworth. With over 6 years of planning and construction, the redevelopment happened in two phases, with the first building, Palvella Glen, opening in February of 2021. This enabled Rockwood to move residents of Rockwood Hawthorne into brand-new apartments in assisted living and memory care.

In May of 2021, we started the construction of the Northland Independent Living building. The Northland consists of 239,000 square feet of overall space and includes 117 independent living apartments ranging in size from 850–1,990 square feet. The Northland took almost exactly 2 years to build, and we began welcoming new residents in April of 2023. Six months after opening the Northland, the community had already welcomed over 140 new residents and hired 69 new employees.

With the redevelopment of Rockwood at Whitworth complete, the lifestyle of being a Rockwood resident is in full swing. In addition to all of the wonderful amenities and services, Rockwood's unique partnership with Whitworth University brings the vibrancy of lifelong learning to the campus. Some of the highlights of the developing partnership have included resident access to athletic events, improv performances by students, Q & A sessions with Whitworth University's President each term, access to Whitworth University courses, use of the aquatic center, and much more.

Through our partnership, Whitworth University students are benefiting as well with a "Community Mentors" program. A resident is paired with a student for the duration of the student's program. Residents can participate as clinical subjects with whom the students can engage and practice, giving them great hands-on experience. The opportunities within our university partnership are endless and will continue to evolve as time progresses.

## Taking The Lead

We take pride in supporting our team members who strive to serve our residents and the organization as agents of change and quality service. We'd like to recognize the following people for their accomplishments.

The Rockwood at Whitworth Sales Team was awarded the National Construction Sales Team of the Year at the Greystone Sales Adventure 2023 in Dallas in late February. In addition, Monica Waitt was awarded Healthcare Services Counselor of the Year. The Rockwood at Whitworth Sales Team held depositors for 4 years and 1 month due to starting pre-sales early to achieve financing for the health care redevelopment. The team achieved 95% presold and replaced 63 cancellations through this timeframe and continued to hold depositors before occupancy was available due to ongoing construction delays. Monica is responsible for maintaining occupancy for 72 assisted living and memory support apartments. When Monica started at Palvella Glen, occupancy was around 80% with a goal to reach stabilization. Within months Monica reached that goal and in 2023, month after month, Monica managed to maintain over 96% occupancy.

Annually, LeadingAge WA member organizations are asked to nominate individuals, programs and/or groups who meet varying criteria for the Awards of Excellence. We are so proud of the dedication, care and innovation that these team members, residents and/or their programs have given to the enrichment of the lives of residents and team members at Rockwood Retirement Communities.

Leslie Malloy, RSH Wellness Director, has found innovative and challenging ways for residents of all abilities to get out and get moving! Taking residents on adventures like snowshoeing, river rafting, rock climbing, and parasailing, Leslie has embraced ways for residents to challenge themselves and have fun taking part in our fitness program. Congratulations on receiving the Leading–Edge Care and Services Award.

Marianne McCormack, Director of Development, and Judi Young, Rockwood Residents' Foundation Chair, have done an amazing job of educating and engaging residents and team members in the many ways that the Foundation provides support to Rockwood during the pandemic and post-pandemic. Congratulations on receiving the Excellence in Leadership Award.

Autumn Sumner, RSH NAC, has been with Rockwood for 19 years and has exemplified the quality care and faithful service Rockwood strives to provide. 

## A Vision Come True

Rockwood South Hill has desired to have a Physician Clinic on-site for some time through our strategic plan, and finally that vision has come true in 2023. In July, Dr. Tina Swiggum opened her private practice on the South Hill campus. Patients from outside Rockwood came with her but primarily she is serving Rockwood South Hill residents and team members. Dr. Swiggum has already reached over 600 patients in less than 6 months and is currently not accepting any new outside patients. What a great success!

The Rockwood Residents' Foundation helped to spur a campaign of fundraising to support the costs needed to remodel the space and supply the clinic with equipment. This special fundraising campaign for the clinic raised approximately \$84,000, which surpassed the \$60,000 goal in two weeks! The funds were used to purchase all the necessary equipment to operate the clinic, such as vitals machines, exam tables, and an EKG machine.

Residents and team members have access to a primary care physician on-site and, when needed, the ability for same-day appointments. Dr. Swiggum has enjoyed getting to know those in our community and to provide more attentive personal care. Tina and her medical assistant, Crystal, work part-time and enjoy having this work-life balance. This unique partnership is a win-win for all.
